

Appetizers

- **Po Pia Tod**
Crispy spring rolls with mung bean noodles, wood ear mushrooms, shredded carrot, cabbage, and ground pork. Served with a sweet chili sauce. \$4.95
- **Po Pia Sod**
Fresh Thai spring rolls with cucumber, Chinese sausage, bean sprouts, egg and green onion. Served with tamarind sauce. \$5.50
- **Gai Satay**
Grilled marinated chicken skewers served with a curried peanut sauce, cucumber salad and toast points. \$6.95

Miang Kam

Thai lettuce wraps with peanuts, dried shrimp, ginger, lime, toasted coconut, chilies and shallots. Served with a salty-sweet shrimp sauce. \$5.95

Taohoo Tod

Fried firm tofu served with a peanut cilantro chili sauce. \$3.95

Tod Mun

Curried fish cakes with kaffir lime leaves. Served with peanut, cucumber relish. \$6.95

Isaan Sticky Rice Dishes

All items served with a basket of warm sticky rice. Combine several items to create an Isaan meal.

- **Som Tum**
Green papaya salad with yard long beans, garlic, Thai chilies, tomatoes, dried shrimp in a traditional lime dressing. \$7.95
- **Laab Gai**
Spicy Isaan salad featuring chopped chicken with toasted rice powder, mint, lime and lemongrass. \$7.95
- **Saikrog Isaan**
Northeastern Thailand's pork sausage with green onions and garlic. Grilled and served with peanuts, ginger, shallots and Thai chilies. \$7.95
- **Yum Goong**
Spicy shrimp salad with cilantro, mint, lemongrass, and onion in a lime dressing. \$10.95
- **Peak Gai Tod**
Crispy fried marinated chicken wings served with nam plaa prik pbon, a spicy, salty dipping sauce. \$6.95
- **Nuea Yang Naam Tok**
Marinated flank steak grilled, thinly sliced and served with lime, green onion, toasted rice powder, mint and cilantro. \$9.95
- **Nuea Dat Deow**
Sweet dried beef seasoned with coriander seeds. \$6.95

Noodle Dishes

At Bangkok's street side noodle and rice stands, spice is typically added to dishes according to individual preference at the table (and by you!)

- **Pad See Iew Gai**
Stir fry wide rice noodles with sweet soy, marinated chicken and Chinese broccoli. \$9.95
- **Guay Teow Neua Sup**
Chopped beef stir fried with yellow curry powder, onion and tomato served over wide rice noodles and fresh greens. Mildly spicy. \$9.95
- ■ **Pad Kee Mao**
Stir fry wide rice noodles with garlic, Thai chilies, Thai basil, tomato and onion. Choose chicken or pork. \$9.95
- ■ **Khao Soi**
Curried Chaing Mai egg noodle dish with beef, cilantro, pickled mustard greens, and shallots. \$11.95
- **Ba Mee Haeng**
Thin egg noodles served with barbeque pork, lettuce, fried garlic, bean sprouts and cilantro. (Or try this dish as a soup: Ba Mee Naam) \$9.95
- **Geow Naam Moo Daeng**
Shrimp and pork won tons in a light chicken broth with egg noodles, nappa cabbage, barbeque pork, green onion, fried garlic and bean sprouts. \$10.95
- **Pad Woon Sen**
Glass bean thread noodle stir fry with chicken and shrimp combination, carrots, peapods, egg and onion. \$11.95
- **Rad Naa Neua**
Wide rice noodles topped with a stir fry of beef, Chinese broccoli and carrots in a yellow bean soy sauce. \$10.95
- **Pad Thai Goong**
Stir fry rice stick noodles with shrimp and tofu, peanuts, bean sprouts, and green onion. \$11.95 Substitute chicken \$9.95

Rice Dishes

Naam pla prik (fish sauce with chilies) may be added to any rice dish at the table for extra saltiness and spice.

Khao Pad Kapi

Royal fried rice, a favorite of Rama V, with dried fried shrimp, green beans, sweet pork, green mango, omelet, shallots and Thai chilies. \$11.95

■ Khao Pad Kuri

Curry fried rice with pineapple, chicken, onion and tomato. Mildly spicy. \$9.95

■ Khao Pad Gai

Thai fried rice with chicken, tomato, onion and egg. \$9.95
Substitute shrimp. \$11.95

Khao Mun Gai

Steamed rice cooked in chicken broth with steamed chicken and gingered bean sauce. Served with a side of broth for sipping. \$10.95

Khao Moo Daeng

Barbeque pork with cucumber slices and green onion. Served over steamed rice. \$10.95

○ ■ Pad Bpai Gra Pow

Thai basil stir fry with ground pork or chicken, garlic, chilies and long bean. Served with steamed rice, topped with a fried egg. \$10.95

Pad Pak Taohoo

Stir fried vegetable medley with garlic and tofu in a lightly sweet and salty sauce. Served with steamed rice. \$10.95

○ Pad Prik Khing

Stir fry of pork and long bean with khing curry paste and kaffir lime leaves. Served with steamed rice. \$9.95

■ Pad Med Mamuang

Cashew chicken stir fry with dried chili pepper, red bell pepper, garlic and green onion. Served with steamed rice. \$11.95
